PRODUCT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

Bolzen Commando 4822D

Bolzen, take product quality and safety very seriously. Bolzen has submitted a voluntary recall for the safety of our customers as unfortunately, Bolzen has identified that the folding mechanism pivot bolt may fail in use. Bolzen has received warranty reports that the bolt has snapped on the thread. If the bolt fails while riding, it could lead to excessive play and semi detach from the deck. This could increase the risk of an accident resulting in serious injury.

Bolzen is working with the Australian Competition & Consumer Commission (“ACCC”) to recall the Bolzen Commando 4822D. All users should immediately stop riding the scooter and contact their retailer to organise for the works required to be carried out. Burley will provide a replacement bolt and the works free of charge to the customer.

ONLY the Bolzen 4822D has been affected.
